

REPAIR THE SPINAKER

SMALL TEAR: 1. Clean properly the cloth with some alcohol. 2. Apply the sail repair glue on the cloth. 3. Proceed on the same way on the other side. *Kits: Big rescue Kit , kit spi/dacron or SAIL REPAIR glue.*

<p>Clean properly with some alcohol, and allow to dry before apply the glue.</p>  <p>1</p>	<p>Use small drop of glue is enough</p>  <p>2</p>	<p>Apply on the 2 sides of the cloth. The sail is repaired.</p>  <p>3</p>
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BIG TEAR: 1. Clean properly the cloth with some alcohol. 2. Join face to face the fiber of the cloth. If the tear is big, maintain the tear with some adhesive tape (easy to remove) placed underneath. 3. Apply the adhesive fiber along the rip.

 <p>1</p>	<p>Some adhesive tape placed underneath will help to maintain the cloth in its place.</p>  <p>2</p>	 <p>3</p>
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

4. If the rip is not straight, place the adhesive fiber end to end but do not stack. Do not forget to remove the plastic protection from the fiber. 5. With the applicator, spread a thin layer of REPAIR SAIL on top of the fiber. 6. Allow to dry for 20mn, and apply another thin layer of REPAIR SAIL on the other side if the rip. Allow drying for 1 hour before use the sail..

Kits: Big Rescue Kit, Kit spi dacron.

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REPAIR WITH SELF ADHESIVE SPINAKER: 1. Clean properly with some alcohol. 2. Cut a piece of cloth at the needed size, with rounded corners. 3. Apply the patch on both sides of the rip.

Kits: Big Rescue Kit, Small rescue kit, Kit self adhesive spi.
